CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter will show the discussion comprise of Background of the Study, Statement of Problem, Purposes of the Study, Significance of the Study, Scope and Limitation of the Study, and Definition of Key Terms.

1. Background of the Study

Listening is the ability to precisely accept and translate messages in the communication process. Related to Solak (2016), listening is the method of accepting, developing meaning from and reacting to spoken and/or non-verbal messages. According to Ahmadi (2016), listening is actual significant in language learning because it gives input for learners and it has more an important role in the development of learner's language knowledge. Conducted to Tran (2012), listening is a receptive skill that intertwines with the ability to read, and the listener's function is no longer passive but active, with a complex process for grasping and understanding spoken language. "It is hard to explain since this is an elusive mental process". This includes interpreting the speaker's accent or pronounciation, as well as grammar, vocabulary, and meaning. Grounded of the citation above, listening is an active and accurate method to learning new languages because learning languages start from hearing what other people say, and evolve it in order to give respond towards other people. It means listening is an important skill to help understand words and basic phrases when people speak slowly and clearly.

Listening skills seem to be the most difficult for students to master among

the four basic English language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing). Based on Renandya & Farrell (2010), students' struggles in listening comes not just from their inability to hear sounds or words, but also from their failure to understand the gist or important information of the spoken text. Related to Hughes (2003), during the listening process, students are bound to end up into some difficulties. For examples, they rarely get the chance to hear the speech again or listen at their own speed and intensity. They must continue to listen regardless of what happens, and as a result, some of them skip crucial parts of the recording. Second, listeners believe the tape is moving quickly. As a consequence, students may consider listening to be difficult and they feel demotivated. Kurniasih (2011), argues that listening exercises in EFL classes are often viewed by teachers as easy ways for students to practice passively listening to English. Based on Nascimento (2018) Teaching Listening is an important addition to our course's literature. Since people believe it is a naturally acquired skill, people conduct exercises to test listening without properly teaching listening, and as a result, it receives less attention in the classroom.

Listening should be considered a part of learning English or developing someone English by those who want to learn that as well. Listening will help people develop their English skills even more. People would be able to reply after listening to the speaker, because listening is related to speaking. In SMP Islam Brawijaya Kota Mojokerto, based on the less interest of the students who assume that listening is difficult for them, listening requires a lot of attention. In addition, the teacher did

not have anything innovative to deliver the material to the students. They only teach the lesson using traditional methods. Traditional teaching focuses on the teacher as the master of the learning environment; however, this method may not provide students with valuable skills or a body of information that will last long after the term has finished. In reality, listening subjects will help students develop their language skills. Khosravani Mahboobeh (2014), argue that listening is not only a passive but also an active method of selecting and interpreting information for the auditory participant, which includes visual imagery.

Concerning the preliminary research at SMP Islam Brawijaya Kota Mojokerto, the researcher discovered that the students have difficulty listening because they believe it is a difficult skill to master. Furthermore, the teacher should assiststudents in learning listening, but learning listening at SMP Islam Brawijaya Kota Mojokerto dominated by traditional technical teaching method, which causes students to lose interest in learning English.

Since students want to practice listening in a variety of ways, the researcher uses a digital media to assist teacher in teaching listening. In order to help the process of learning English listening materials in the class, the researcher must provide the students with suitable teaching method on learning listening materials. Teaching method is a way of teaching specified to applied in communicate knowledge and intelligence to the students. As a result, using effective teaching strategies is critical in the teaching listening materials. The researcher is interested in using Quizziz to solve the problem described above.

Quizizz (2019), explain that Quizizz is a free, fun, formative, multiplayer evaluation tool that works on a computer, tablet, or smartphone. Each participant or student group requires one package, but they do not need to create an account with Quizizz because they can participate by simply entering the game code. Eser Çeker (2017), said that Quizizz can move a large number of tasks, repeat them, entertain them, and accommodate a large number of people. Based on Suo Yan Mei (2018), Quizizz questions and answers appear on each participant's computer or mobile phone screen; as a result, it appears to be personalized, however it does include response analysis. Quizizz keeps students engaged and focused on the content they're studying. Conducted to Huisman (2018), Quizizz explains and detects both incorrect and correct answers for each learner, making it more successful so the material that needs to be corrected can be identified. Related to Ishak, Nor, & Ahmad (2017), some studies conducted in different countries, learners welcome the use of Quizizz in their learning. It helps the class to be more interactive because it is conducted online, with questions and answers appearing on the screen prior to the start of the class. According to Chaiyo & Nokham (2017) argue that the students in Thailand, Quizizz helps to increase attention, engagement, enjoyment, and motivation while studying. Furthermore, these applications assist learners in recognizing their awareness level, facilitating idea perception, improving the learning experience, and feeling as though their response is being evaluated by a teacher. The teacher can easily review the students' answers since they are accessible automatically and online.
