

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is the last chapter which contains conclusions and suggestions.

A. Conclusion

From the results of the research above, the researcher concludes that pre-service teachers understand TPACK in terms of technology for learning media (mobile phones, laptops, youtube, PowerPoint, Zoom, google classroom, Quizziz), learning methods (discovery learning, cooperative learning, question and answer, problem-solving, discussion, problem-based learning), educational theory (humanistic, cognitive, constructive, behavioristic), and creating English content to facilitate English language teaching.

Pre-service teachers also believe that integrating TPACK in the English learning process influences the ease of material delivery and student assignments or assessments. Then, technology makes it easier for pre-service teachers for administrative purposes (exercise via Google Classroom, Google Forms, and Quizzes) and saves time.

However, after using various technologies, the students can understand English lesson material because they feel fun and easy.

B. Suggestion

Students can have a new and fun English learning style because technology teaches students to remember English lesson material that can build students' enthusiasm.

d. Further Researcher

For further researchers, the results of this study are expected to serve as information and references related to integrating TPACK. The researcher suggests that future researchers use the TPACK framework so that learning English in the classroom is fun, easy, comfortable, and not dated out.
