Consequently, it can be confidently concluded that the combination of Ecofeminism and Connectivism proves highly effective in enhancing students' narrative writing abilities.

Through an intricate analysis of the collected data, the t-test results have unveiled a compelling revelation regarding the impact of the Ecofeminism approach combined with the Connectivism method on students' writing ability. The findings show that the significance level (Sig. 2-tailed) is astonishingly lower than the critical value of 0.05. This remarkable discovery strongly supports the acceptance of the alternative hypothesis (H α), indicating a substantial and noteworthy effect of this innovative teaching approach on students' writing prowess.

Moreover, the meticulous evaluation of the questionnaire's validity has rendered equally fascinating outcomes. By comparing the computed r-count value with the r-table value provided in table, it has been conclusively established that the questionnaire data holds utmost validity. This further bolsters the credibility and reliability of the study's findings.

With robust and reliable evidence, it can be firmly believed that the Ecofeminism approach, when combined with the Connectivism method, wields a profound influence on students' narrative writing abilities. The amalgamation

of these two pedagogical strategies has proven to be an effective and transformative means of empowering students and elevating their writing proficiency to greater heights.
